

REFLECTION

Today's gospel, which tells of the coming-to-faith of Peter and the beloved disciple John, is neither the most beautiful nor the most moving of those testimonies to the resurrection which all four gospels contain. But it is especially appropriate for use; unlike the loving women, we have not encountered angels at an empty tomb or been surprised at Christ's appearing. Our belief must rest on God's word in scripture and the witness of those before us (Peter's homily in Acts is an example of the earliest preaching). But our faith rests also on our own encounters with Christ through the persons and events of our lives. Time cannot confine him: Christ lives today! Our communion with him is still hidden, our lives still swayed by evil. But one day Christ will be fully revealed; we shall join him in victory and live the Father's glory. Easter calls us to become new people, full of the joy of the living and glorious Lord. Alleluia!
