The poverty of spirit demanded of the disciple and apostle requires a break with the past and the fixing of our hearts on Christ for life. Jesus demands a more unconditional response to his invitation than that given by Elisha in the first reading, who is called by Elijah from his daily work. Christ has liberated us from the law, St. Paul writes to the Galatians, to free us for selfless service to one another. The Spirit will guide us in our loving service, by a way which is above the law because it is the way of love.
