Christ has liberated us from the law, St. Paul writes to the Galatians, to free us for selfless service to one another. The Spirit will guide us in our loving service, by a way which is above the law because it is the way of love.

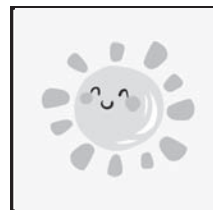
