#### REFLECTION

Does the prospect of a reduced standard of living disturb us? Do we equate material prosperity with God's blessing? Jesus' beatitudes present a radical standard for his disciples. Jesus invites his followers, the little people of the world, to understand that poverty, hunger, tears, persecution for his sake, can be blessings in disguise. But how many Christians in today's affluent western world can count themselves so blessed? Would Jesus pronounce over us the woes addressed to the rich, the filled, the well-entertained, and those who welcome the world's adulation? Jeremiah describes the stunted life of the person who trusts in material things: without a future and isolated, already the curse has taken effect. The one who trusts in God, however, flourishes despite difficult times. Our choice is either to live for God or to trust in the false security of things passing. St. Paul's brief message about Christ's resurrection as central to Christian life is the key. We begin to taste the Lord's blessings; one day we will share his glory. (Sunday Mass Book)
