REFLECTION

We are reminded today of our human vulnerability and deep need for God's nourishment. Just as the legendary pelican feeds her young with her own blood in times of famine, so too does Christ give of himself completely to feed, sustain, and comfort us. St. Thomas Aquinas referenced this image in his hymn *Adoro te devote*, recognizing it as a symbol of Christ's sacrificial love in the Eucharist.

In the Gospel, Jesus instructs his disciples to feed the hungry crowd, showing that God does not leave his people to fend for themselves. He satisfies our spiritual hunger with His body and Blood, nourishing us in a miraculous, intimate way at every Mass.
