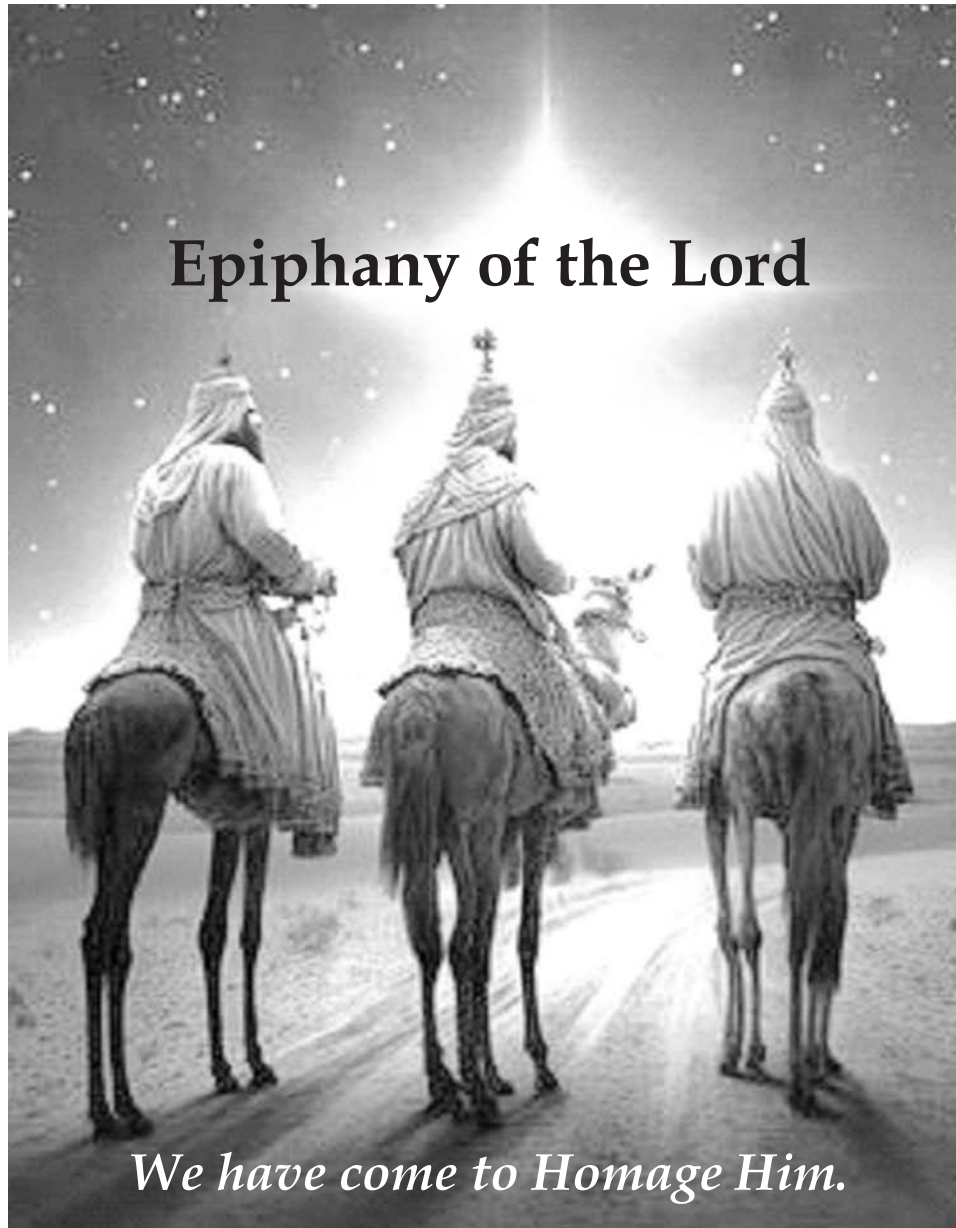

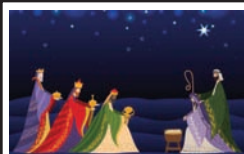

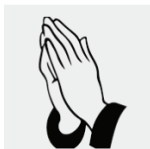

Let us pray for the sick members of our parish, asking God to grant them healing, comfort, and peace. We also pray for those who love them and minister to them, that they may be strengthened with patience, compassion, and hope.



### REFLECTION

The Epiphany reminds us that God reveals Himself in ways that invite attentiveness, wisdom, and faith. Like the Magi who followed the star, we are called to notice the signs of God's presence in creation, in our lives, and in our relationship with Him. While reason and science help us understand the world, God's revelations are not limited by them; they often speak to the heart, calling us beyond information toward transformation. The star that guided the wise men symbolizes how God meets us where we are, using what we can see and understand to draw us closer to Christ. Yet revelation is never meant to remain abstract—it should lead us to deeper faith, mercy, love, and action. The Epiphany challenges us to remain open to God's guidance, to discern His voice carefully, and to allow His light to change our direction, just as it changed the course of the Magi. As we celebrate the Epiphany, we give thanks for Christ who willingly entered our world to liberate us from sin and darkness. We pray for the grace to recognize God's revelations in our own lives and to respond with trust, humility, and a willingness to be transformed by His light.

## Important Update on Parish Envelope Numbers

Due to rising costs and decreased envelope use, envelope numbers will be reassigned **effective in year 2027**. Beginning in 2027, envelope numbers will be reassigned annually to help us use resources wisely. Unused envelope boxes will be reassigned, and boxes will not be issued the following year if they are not used.

If you donate through Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG), please consider switching to a **boxless number**. Your donations will continue to be tracked by number, without the cost of envelope boxes. "2nd Collections only" envelopes can also be provided if needed.
